



Hever Castle Campsite Information 26th, 27th & 28th September 2025

Pitch (2 people) £30.00
Extra Person £8.00 per night (6yrs and over)
Electric hook up pitch £55 per night (available until Monday 9am)

Camping is located within the venue field. This is a Wild Camping site and we are lucky to be able to use this space. When approaching the venue, please follow yellow car park signs / event campsite signs.

Campsite Open: 4.00pm Friday
Campsite Closed: 10.00am Monday

1. ACCESS TO THE CAMPSITE FOR ALL VEHICLES (Sat Nav Post Code: TN8 7LH)

All campers are to make their way to the Car Park entrance (Off Rectory Lane). On approach follow the yellow signage (not your sat-nav) to pick up the correct traffic management plan. Please continue to follow the campsite signage when you get on the estate.

1A. EVENT WRISTBANDS

On arrival please register with the Campsite Manager (James) to pick up your wristband. This will allow access to the Event Village and Hever Castle grounds during the event timings. If James is not immediately available please choose a pitch and seek him out later in your stay. Please make sure you have your wristband before making your way towards the event village

Please do not pitch your tent or park under any trees in the campsite. This is due to the danger of falling branches.

Please note the castle grounds will close at 5pm, please ensure all your party are aware not to roam the grounds after this time – we do not want to lose this unique opportunity to camp onsite.

2. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES (No arrival after 10pm)

This is a family campsite, therefore on Friday and Saturday night, the campsite gates will close at 10pm. Please make sure you arrive before this time. If you think you will be arriving after this time, please get in touch prior to the event and we will make the campsite manager is aware. Campers are to arrive no earlier than 4.00pm on Friday and leave no later than 10.00am on Monday

3. EXITING THE EVENT

Please be aware there will be fast moving cyclists from earlier races on the road as you exit the event site. Only turn **RIGHT on the narrow lane (Rectory Lane). There will be signage to remind you.**

4. LITTER

Please put any litter in the bins provided.

5. FOOD AND DRINK

Food and drink will be available for purchase in the event village whilst it is open for competitors and spectators. There is also a local pub called the Henry VIII, which is a 10-minute walk from the campsite. You can also head down to Hever Castle Golf Club for a leisurely breakfast on Saturday and Sunday (please be aware that you may have to book for the golf club in advance, you can find their details [here](#)).

6. FACILITIES

There will be sufficient toilet, showering and changing facilities available. Running cold water is available from a standpipe in the corner of the campsite field opposite to the showers. Toilets and showers will be regularly cleaned throughout the event weekend and the event timetable will naturally stagger their usage. **There are no foul/soiled water disposal points.** The electricity will be turned off at 9.00am on Monday for all campers!

7. DOGS

Well-behaved dogs on leads are welcome on the estate. Please clear up any dog mess that they may leave behind.

8. FIRES & BBQs

Fires are strictly prohibited on the estate. BBQs that keep their coals and ash off the ground are permitted.

9. SECURITY

The Campsite Manager will be present throughout your stay. We would recommend that valuables and expensive bikes are left under lock and key when not in use.
