



Cholmondeley Castle Campsite Information – Friday 19th, Saturday 20th & Sunday 21st June 2026

Per night: 2 Person Pitch £30.00. Extra Person £8.00 (5yrs and over). Electric hook up pitch £55.

Camping is located within the venue field. This is a wild camping site and we are lucky to be able to use this space. When approaching the venue, please follow event campsite signs.

1. DIRECTIONS AND ACCESS TO THE CAMPSITE

Cholmondeley Castle is located off the A49 Whitchurch / Tarporley Road, between Warrington and Whitchurch. The entrance to the castle is off the A49 at the Cholmondeley Arms Pub crossroads -postcode: SY14 8HN.

Nearest Railway stations are at Chester, Crewe and Whitchurch.

Follow the yellow AA style signs to “Castle Race Series Car Park” from these crossroads and take the right turn into the car park. You will then be directed to the campsite from here.

Due to live racing during the day over the weekend, the Camping area is accessible at the following times:

Friday	4.00pm – 10.00pm
Saturday	06.00am - 8.00am & 5.30pm – 10.00pm
Sunday	06.00am - 8.00am & 2.30pm – 10.00pm
Monday	06.00am – 11.00am when the campsite will close

No vehicles will be allowed to move on the site whilst racing is underway.

If you arrive outside these times please follow signs to the Castle Race Series Car Park and you are welcome to wait there.

Upon arrival in the campsite please report to the Campsite Manager. If the Campsite Manager is unavailable when you arrive, please pitch appropriately and report in, or he'll find you later when he returns. All campers will be given a wristband. This will allow free access into the event and the Cholmondeley Castle grounds over the weekend. Please make sure you have your wristband before making your way towards the event village.

On race day, please head for to Check-In area before registration (located at the bottom of the car park field).

From the campsite you have access on foot to the castle grounds (limited access) and the event village. **Please do not cross over the “ha ha” (an ornamental ditch) and onto the actual castle lawn.** No vehicles will be allowed to move on the site whilst racing is underway. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas when the gates are open to the public.

Please do not pitch your tent or park under any trees in the campsite. This is due to the danger of falling branches.

2. ARRIVAL AFTER 10PM.

Many of the campers will have had very long days or may be on site with children and wish to go to sleep early. As a result any camper who cannot arrive by car before 10.00pm or who wants to leave and come back on site must take special care not to wake others on arrival.

3. RUBBISH

Please take any rubbish with you when you leave or deposit it in the rubbish containers provided.

4. FIRES & BBQs

Fires are strictly prohibited on the estate. BBQs that keep their coals and ash off the ground are permitted.

5. DOGS

Well-behaved dogs are allowed on site. Please clear up any dog mess that they may leave behind.

6. FOOD AND DRINK

Food and drink will be available for purchase on site on race days only.

The event bar will be open on the Friday and Saturday evening. The Cholmondeley Arms, an excellent local pub with great food, is a 15-minute walk from the campsite.

7. FACILITIES

There will be sufficient toilet and showering facilities available adjacent to the campsite. There are **no** foul/soiled water disposal points. Running cold water will be available from a fixed standpipe. **Electric hook up will be turned off on ?? at ??pm**

8. SECURITY

Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday nights. We have an all night walk around security guard on site at all times.

9. ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

This is a family campsite and antisocial behavior of any description will not be tolerated.

Please note the castle grounds will close at 6pm, please ensure all your party are aware not to roam the grounds after this time – we do not want to lose this unique opportunity to camp onsite.

10. YOUNG CHILDREN

Please look after your under 5s as there is a live cycle circuit that effectively goes through the middle of the campsite (there are barriers in place).
