



Belvoir Castle Campsite Information - Friday 17th, Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th July 2026

Pitch (2 people) £30.00
Extra Person £8.00 per night (6yrs and over)
Electric hook up pitch £55 per night (available until Monday 9am)

Camping is located within the venue field. This is a Wild Camping site and we are lucky to be able to use this space. When approaching the venue, please follow event campsite signs.

1. DIRECTIONS AND ACCESS TO THE CAMPSITE

Please use What3words to access the correct entrance [Clubbing.Limit.Wage](#)
Mobile reception is quite poor on event site, please download all necessary information before leaving home.

2. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

Campers are to arrive no earlier than 4.00pm on Friday and leave no later than 11.00am on Monday. For electric hook-up's, the generator will be turned off at 10:00pm on Sunday.

Please do not pitch your tent or park under any large trees in the campsite. This is due to the danger of falling branches.

2A. EVENT WRISTBANDS

On arrival please register with the Campsite Manager (James) to pick up your wristband. This will allow access to the Event Village and Belvoir Castle grounds (not the Castle) during the event timings. If James is not immediately available please choose a pitch and seek him out later in your stay. Please make sure you have your wristband before making your way towards the event village.

The castle grounds will close at 6pm, please ensure all your party are aware not to roam the grounds after this time – we do not want to lose this unique opportunity to camp onsite.

3. ARRIVAL AFTER 10PM

Many of the campers will have had very long days or may be on site with children and wish to go to sleep early. As a result, any campers who cannot arrive before 10pm or who want to leave and come back on site must take special care not to wake others on arrival.

4. RUBBISH

Any rubbish, which you bring on site, will you please take it out with you or deposit it in the rubbish containers provided.

5. STANDPIPES FOR DRINKING WATER

There will also be running cold water available from a stand pipe adjacent to the toilets and showers.
There are **no** foul/soiled water disposal points.

6. DOGS

Well-behaved dogs are allowed on site but they must be kept on a lead Please clear up any dog mess that they may leave behind.

7. FOOD AND DRINK

Food and drink will be available for purchase in the Event Village over the weekend.
Nonna Lucia's pizza van will be in the campsite Saturday night.

The Wheel Inn, an excellent local pub, is a 5-minute drive from the campsite in Branston. Close by, Woolshorpe has a village shop. There are many shops, restaurants and a supermarket in the town of Grantham just 20 minutes away.

9. ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR


This is a family campsite and antisocial behaviour of any description will not be tolerated.
